


Image 1. KARE Bulletin sample






Image 3. COVID quarantine centres - Models developed by Civil Engineering students



- In order to overcome the anxiety and stress in this challenging time, regular counselling sessions towards mental and emotional wellness are organised on the digital platform.






Image 4. Entry pass system followed for campus entry






